2020 CAPER PANCREAS ACADEMY

The Collaborative Alliance for Pancreatic Education and Research's (CAPER) is proud to announce the 4th Annual Pancreas Academy being held Wednesday, July 22, 2020, in Pittsburgh, PA. This program aims to improve healthcare providers' knowledge by delivering a focused update on the most clinically relevant information on areas such as normal pancreatic physiology, pancreatic exocrine insufficiency, pancreatic oncology, and pancreatic endotherapy. Our expert faculty will explain new keys to pathogenesis, clinical manifestations, replacement of pancreatic enzymes, and optimal therapeutic approaches. In addition, a focus will be placed on early detection of pancreatic cancer; identifying risk factors, advances in screening, diagnosis, and the latest neoadjuvant treatment modalities for pancreatic cancer.

This activity has been designed to meet the educational needs of physicians, GI fellows, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, and nurses involved in the care of patients with pancreatic diseases.

The 2019 Pancreas Academy attracted over 105 attendees from across the country. The primary conference audience is GI fellows with an interest in pancreatology. Some of the highlights and educational outcomes of the program include:

- 90% rated the speakers as outstanding or good
- 83% indicated that the program will affect their practice
- Participant knowledge improved as measured in a pre and post-course assessment in 57%-71% of participants

Awardees will have the unique chance to present their abstract at the 2020 PancreasFest, providing access to a network of renowned leaders in the field of pancreatology and an opportunity to make mentorship connections with renowned pancreatologists.

CAPER TRAINEE WEBINAR SERIES


